APPOINTMENTS SYSTEM

We understand it can be frustrating phoning the Practice at 8am for an appointment and have been looking to see how we can make things easier and more efficient. Primary care is under immense pressure and the reality is demand for appointments often outweighs availability. We ask patients to be mindful that you do not always need to see a GP, there are other professionals who may be able to help. Our experienced admin team may navigate you elsewhere keeping in mind the 'right care, right place' model, NHS inform is also a great information tool. We have introduced eConsult as an alternative way of getting in touch, more info below. In the coming months we will be changing our appointments system to incorporate some more pre bookable slots and ask that you bear with us during the transition. Keep an eye on our website and social media for more information. We always endeavour to prioritise patients who require a GP consultation. NHS inform and our eConsult system may be able to help direct you elsewhere or give you advise to enable you to self care if appropriate.

ECONSULT

eConsult is a digital triage and online consultation platform that allows NHS GP practices to better understand the needs of their patients. By collecting rich, safe and structured patient information, patients can be better supported to get the right care at the right time and in the right place.

Patients are also encouraged to check their symptoms, find verified NHS self-help information and find appropriate local or self-referral services, or submit consultations for their dependents.

It has been designed by NHS GPs to enhance patient access, improve practice efficiencies and empower practices to support their patients effectively. Head to our website for more details or to submit an eConsult.

We have updated these recently and are pleased to announce they are back in working order.

Repeat prescription line

We will be closing our repeat prescription line from 1st September 2023. There are many others way to order your repeat prescriptions which include: handing it into reception or posting in the letterbox outside, order online (see website for detail or ask reception staff) or hand in into the chemist. These methods ensure the correct drugs are ordered at the correct time and mean staff can deal with them more efficiently.



VERBAL ABUSE

Unfortunately our staff are still subjected to abuse over the phone and at the reception desk regularly. This is not acceptable and offenders will be dealt with appropriately. Calls are recorded and you may receive a follow up call if your language is felt to be inappropriate. Our staff try their best to help patients and the majority are very thankful and pleasant which is appreciated.
